- 4. Each entry must be centered on a CARDSTOCK or BRISTOL BOARD exposing a 5.5cm border on all four sides.
- 5. Wilberforce Fair, District #4, Contact: Joanne Vanier, name of owner of poster, and complete mailing address must be clearly labeled on the back of each entry.
- 6. The winning poster from each class at each fair will be eligible to enter the district competition. District winners are eligible to enter at the provincial competition.
