- 53. Junior: Entries up to and including Grade 4
 - 54. Intermediate: Entries include youth, Grade 5 to Grade 8 inclusive
 - 55. Senior: Entries include youth, Grade 9 to Grade 12 inclusive
- Prizes 1st - \$5, 2nd - \$4, 3rd - \$3, 4th - \$2

Entry Rules

- 1. "Promoting Your Fair" - Name and date of fair must be clearly shown on poster.
- 2. Must be hand drawn, no raised items. Must lay flat.
- 3. Poster size: Minimum - approximately 8.5" X 11", without border
Maximum - approximately 11" X 17", without border
- 4. Each entry must be centered on a CARDSTOCK or BRISTOL BOARD exposing a 2" border on all four sides.

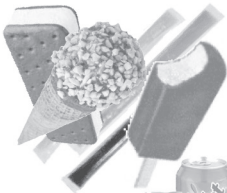
The winning poster from each class at each fair will be eligible to enter the district competition. District winners are eligible to enter at the provincial competition.
